Alaska Marine Pilots remind all agents, owners, and masters of vessels of the following regulations and conditions:

**The Aleutian Island ports west of Atka Island require a 96 hour notice of vessel movement. All other ports require a 48 hour notice. See Marine Pilot Regulations 12AAC-56.205 AVAILABILITY OF PILOTS.**

If safe and reliable transportation cannot be provided to or from the pilot station, the nearest pilot station with safe and reliable transportation shall be used. See Marine Pilot Regulations 12AAC-56.120 PILOT STATIONS OR PICK UP POINTS (c).

Refer to Marine Pilot Regulations 12AAC-56.120 (d) (1-14) for the requirements to provide a safe and reliable transportation for pilots.

Standby and Riding Pilotage Services are to be provided at the discretion of AMP.

A change in dispatch request shall be treated as a new dispatch request and be subject to Marine Pilot Regulation 12AAC-56.205 AVAILABILITY OF PILOTS.
